

# West Jordan High School AIP Disclosure

## Objective:

The West Jordan High School Academic Intervention Period (AIP) is designed to help students improve and succeed in their academics. During the school day time is provided, after 1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> period, Monday thru Thursday, for students to study, complete homework, and receive remediation from WJHS faculty members.

## Format:

The first two weeks of the school year all students are assigned to an AIP class. They will attend this class daily. In this class they will receive information from counseling, administration, student government, pathways, as well as, their instructors. Then, on Sept. 6th, students will receive an AIP card. This card will show the student their current grades and will inform them whether or not they are required to continue going to AIP.

If the student is passing all of their classes they will not be required to go to AIP. The student will be allowed independent study time. However, the student may still choose to go to an AIP class to get additional help, make up tests or quizzes or study. The media center, the computer labs, the commons, and the gym will be available for those not required to attend an AIP class.

If the student is receiving 1 or more failing grades they will be required to attend an AIP class. The student may choose which of their classes they would like to attend each day; however, the classes with failing grades should be the focus. Attendance will be taken, through the Skyward system, when the student checks in to an AIP class.

Grades and AIP attendance will be re-evaluated every week and new AIP cards will be issued. It is the responsibility of the student to keep their AIP card with them at all times. If a student loses their AIP card they will be required to go to an AIP class until new cards are issued.

## Receiving Credit:

If a student attends an AIP class forty (40) or more times in a semester they will receive .25 hours of elective credit.

## Expectations:

If a student is required to attend AIP they will:

- Go to the class in which they need the most help
- Come prepared with work to do and specific questions they need help on



## Rules:

The following will not be allowed during AIP:

- No cell phones, i-pods or electronics
- No food or drink
- No hall pass use.

Each teacher may have additional rules to follow according to the subject matter and/or needs of the particular classroom.

**During AIP, West Jordan is a closed campus. Students will not be able to leave school.**

If you need to check your student out during AIP you must follow the appropriate check out procedure.
