Who is the School Community Council and what do they do?

Every school must have a School Community Council (SCC) that consists of the principal, school employees and parents. The majority of members are parents. Parents represent parent perspectives on issues and decisions made by the council. Parents have input in the School Improvement Plan and in how the funds from the School LAND Trust Program will be spent. Parents have the majority vote.

What other responsibilities do councils have?

- Parents may bring issues of concern to the council seeking solutions. The council may choose to address them or recommend another group or entity better suited to implement solutions.
- The council may also create programs or projects to improve the parent, student & faculty school experience
- They may make recommendations to the administration of the school and district.

Requirements

Members should be willing to attend the council meetings that are held four times during the year on Wednesdays at 5:00 PM. Our meetings this year are scheduled October 12, January 11, February 15, and March 29. Members of the council will need to agree to have their email and/or phone number published. We recommend that new members of the School Community Council attend one of the orientation sessions held at several locations. Bingham High on Oct. 12, West Jordan Middle on Oct. 13, Herriman High on Oct. 26, JATC- South on October 27, Riverton High on Nov. 2, and Copper Hills High on Nov. 3. Sessions will begin at 6:00.
