



### **Academic Intervention Time (AIP)**

Did you know your student can earn .25 hours of elective credits for going to AIP at least 40 times during the semester? All they have to do is go to a class they need help in, or would like to do additional studying in, and key in. If they don't key in it's like they aren't even there, so make sure to remind them to go to AIP and to key in. 267 students took advantage of this 1<sup>st</sup> semester.

Next week students will go to their assigned (9<sup>th</sup> period) AIP class to receive various lessons including: Suicide Prevention, Scholarships, ACT Strategies, Registration, and Organization. Then on January 30<sup>th</sup> they will receive a mini report card. If they are failing a class they will need to go back to that class. If they are passing all of their classes they can go to the commons, the media center, or the gym OR if they want to earn credit they can go to a classroom (in their schedule) and work.

AIP disclosures were signed at the beginning of the year, so no need to sign and return this, but here is a reminder of what AIP is and why we have it.

### **Registration Information for 2017-18**

We are excited to announce the registration process for the 2017-2018 school year has changed. The basic process is as follows:

1. Students will get the opportunity to request the courses they want by filling out a registration card.
  - 9<sup>th</sup> graders will do this during their Geography class the week of Feb. 13-16.
  - 10<sup>th</sup> graders will do this during their History Class the week of Feb. 6-10.

- 11<sup>th</sup> graders will do this during their Junior PCCR meeting (theses are scheduled between Feb. 21-Mar. 6)
2. Course requests will then be used to build the Master Schedule based on what the students request.
  3. Student schedules will be created for them based on their requests and they will be able to see them at the beginning of May.
    - This allows more students to get into the courses they want by enabling us to eliminate many of the scheduling conflicts that have occurred in the past.
    - It also eliminates the stress of having to figure out a complicated Master Schedule for students and parents.
  4. The Arena scheduling window will be opened the week of May 8th for students to *customize* their schedules.
